

# 2020 Camper Code of Conduct - Covid 19

Birch Cove Campgrounds welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct and review it with all family members. **It is your responsibility that everyone residing at your lot is aware and will follow this code. Please sign and return by email or to the office.** The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. For your own comfort and safety you may want to bring a mask, gloves or hand sanitizer.

**This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Upon signing, you will continue to follow and understand the Birch Cove Campgrounds Rules/Regulations/Waiver.**

If you have a fever or flu-type symptoms, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days. If you are returning from travel from outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days, please remain home. At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation.

## **Visitors**

Until further notice there are no visitors allowed. Seasonal campers only, and registered second families will be permitted.

## **Common Areas - CLOSED**

The following common areas are closed until further notice. All areas that are closed are indicated with a sign or tape. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification.

- Washrooms/ Laundry room
- Playground
- Shuffleboard
- Recreation hall

## **Common Areas – OPEN FOR SAFE USE ONLY**

The following common areas will be accessible for use with your own personal equipment ONLY. Parents MUST accompany children to ensure social distancing rules are OBEYED AT ALL TIMES.

- Baseball diamond/ basketball court ( one family only)

- Horseshoe pits (One family only – every other pit)
- Beaches/G&G point/Boat Launch (current physical distancing and group size guidelines must be followed)

**Limit of Campers in an Area ( includes walking and bicycling)**

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules as mandated by the Province of Ontario. Currently, you must stay 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers.

**Limit of People on a Campsite**

Until such time as the Government of Ontario amends the number of people allowed to gather, we are limiting the number of people allowed on a campsite to no more than 5. The exception being if you are a family of more than 5 living in the same household. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE ON YOUR CAMPSITE AND RESPECT THE GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS THAT ARE IN PLACE.

**Children under the age of 16**

Although it is difficult, we expect parents to monitor and ensure children understand and will follow our guidelines, especially for physical distancing and current closed areas.

**Events/Activities**

There will be no events or scheduled activities until the social distancing and social gathering restrictions from the government have been lifted.

**Golf Carts**

Only the registered owner and campers on the same lot are permitted in the cart.

**Office**

The office is open for limited hours. ( 10 am - 4pm). At this point the inside of the office is closed. Interactions will take place at our side window. While waiting outside the office please obey all social distancing rules.

**Respect of Others and Staff**

All campers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore, or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance and diversity at all times.
